On April 21 Denny and I deliver a 1420 Pro Series AmTryke® to a very special girl at Olympia High School. Hannah has been waiting a few months for her special bike. As you can tell from the pictures below Hannah was pleased with her new bike. She is usually very quite but she was quite excited with she realized we were rolling her new bike down the hall to her. She was so patient with us as we made the adjustments on her new bike.



Jennifer Bauersfield was the key therapist involved in working with us to get the bike for Hannah. Jennifer has evaluated several other children who attend the Olympia School district. Jennifer is great to work with and is always so appreciative of what we do for the kids. Two other therapists at the school express interest in helping us build a ramp or two this summer and possible joining our chapter.

This was the first bike of the new style we received. The improvements in the seat adjustments sure helped get the bike adjusted quickly and exactly where Jennifer felt it needed to be for Hannah. Also, the new hand brake was much easier to assemble and adjust.

We also worked with a therapist at Parkside Elementary and have order a bike for a young boy from Hudson. We are hoping the bike is here in time to be presented at the Installation Banquet on May 12<sup>th</sup>.
