Shopping makes Cents

Be sure to have your Kroger Plus card handy and register your card with your organization (Cornbelt AMBUCS[™]) after you sign up.

If you do not yet have a Kroger Plus card, you can get one at the customer service desk at any Kroger.

Click on Sign In/Register

If you are a new online customer, you must click on SIGN UP TODAY in the 'New Customer?' box.

Sign up for a Kroger Rewards Account by entering zip code, clicking on favorite store, entering your email address and creating a password, agreeing to the terms and conditions

You will then get a message to check your email inbox and click on the link within the body of the email.

Click on My Account and use your email address and password to proceed to the next step. Click on Edit Kroger Community Rewards information and input your Kroger Plus card number. Update or confirm your information.

Enter NPO number (73396) or name of organization (Cornbelt Chapter), select organization from list and click on confirm.

To verify you are enrolled correctly, you will see your organization's name on the right side of your information page.

REMEMBER, purchases will not count for us until after you register your Kroger Plus card. Do you use your phone number at the register? Call <u>800-576-4377</u>, select option 4 to get your Kroger Plus card number.

Members must swipe their registered Kroger Plus card or use the phone number that is related to their registered Kroger Plus card when shopping for each purchase to count.

Smile.Amazon.Com Fund Raiser

Amazon also has a program where they will donate 1/2% of your purchase price to AMBUCSTM. It is really a simple process - check it out.

When you shop on Amazon, log in with the link smile.amazon.com . It is a super simple way to help out AMBUCS[™] without spending an extra cent!
