### **AMBUC™** of the Year - Vicky Strauss



We got two ramps built in May and we've got several more phone calls for individuals wanting our services. Here's what we did in May.



May might have seemed a little slow for many Cornbelt members but we were quite busy with evaluations and request for AmTrykes®.

We completed evaluations and did assemble several bikes that had been previously oversold. (That is another way of saying they were on back order.) About 10 of us gathered one evening and assembled 5 1420 Pro Series bikes. They all were the new design which allows for a heavier rider and has a dual hub. The dual hub allows for the bike to be fixed drive

or the ability to coast. Watch for the next newsletter for pictures of the kids on their new bikes as I clean out the garage and make room to get the truck back in the garage.

We also gave one bike away in May. It was to an AM-12 Small. Eshan's request was from Easter Seals and yes Jamie was the referring therapist again. Once she has her third child maybe we can persuade her to become an Ambuc™.
