<u>Amtrykes®</u>

Amtryke activities were just a little slower last month than the previous month.

We received one request for a new bike for a young boy who has outgrown his current bike. The child is blind so he will definitely need rear steering for his next bike. The board will review the request during their August Cornbelt Board meeting.

We also deliver a JT 2300 bike to Thomas last month. Thomas is 16 years old a good sized young man with very large feet. Our largest exercise pedals had to be redesigned to fit his feet. Thomas lives out in the country so the next day Thomas and his mother were riding the bike trail in Bloomington/Normal. After about 2 ½ miles the rear brake assemble fell of the bike and they could not complete the ride. Appears this was not tighten properly at the factory as this is not part of the chapter bike assembly process. Either way the bike was repaired and returned to Thomas the next day as he is getting many opportunities to ride his new bike as shown below:
