Paul is a 6-year-old energetic boy who lives in Atlanta, Illinois. Paul had an Amtryke a few years ago. He rode the previous Amtryke so much he wore it out and outgrew the bike. Paul enjoys riding and being active with his family. Paul has Autism Spectrum Disorder but I am sure he will be able to ride his new Amtryke when the weather is permissible.

As you can see from the picture below, Paul loves his new bike and is ready to go.



The second Amtryke that afternoon was presented to Rex. Rex is also 6 years old. He is from Bloomington and has autism, hypotonia and sensory processing disorder (ADHD). Rex's family became aware of the Amtryke Program from his mother's cousin Kim and Marc in Ohio. Marc and Kim were our National Therapist of the Year and they recommended Rex's parents to contact us regarding an Amtryke for Rex.

With a few adaptive devices Rex was able to ride his new Amtryke. Rex needs assistance with braking and steering. Both are provided by the rear steering we added to Rex's bike. Note Rex's little sister is helping him ride the bike. How wonderful is this.
