I'm an AMBUCTM. For me, the solution was simple. Build a ramp. Surely I could do that. So, on a weekend trip to the Quad Cities last month, I loaded the car up with all the tools I could get my hands on, made a trip to Menard's for some lumber, and built a ramp. It was a nice Saturday afternoon project.

That I built a ramp is no big deal. The difference it's made for my family, especially my father, however, is a big deal. I've seen people take that 'maiden voyage' down a new ramp. I've got to tell you, it's a completely different experience watching your own father do the same thing. Sure, it makes the trips to church or the doctor easier, but it also reopens a portion of the world to him, and lets him do other 'normal' things that you and I take for granted. Last week he went to the mail box and got his own mail. A simple daily task, but something he hadn't done in years!!

I'm getting to see what we do as a club from a completely different point of view. In case you had any doubts, or needed a little reminding, the things we do as a club really do make a big difference in the lives of the people we help. If you haven't been out to a ramp build in the last couple months, make a point to get out there soon with the rest of our Cornbelt team. The builds are fun, the 'maiden voyages' are unforgettable.
