We need to thank Karen Klien, Cornbelt's 2010 Therapist of the Year, for her help in arranging this purchase. Karen was fortunate to have worked and knew Sue Preston. Karen indicated Sue spent 35 plus years with District 87 and working with the youngest children at Raymond School. Prior to passing away last July at age 60, Sue enriched the lives of countless families over more than one generation and would have been very proud to have played a part in seeing those special kids benefiting from an AmTryke® at Raymond School.

Our second bike was purchased with donated funds from Denny, Dennis, Sonny, Dewayne and myself.
