- If you are a new online customer, you must click on SIGN UP TODAY in the 'New Customer?' box.

Cornbelt has been working with a therapist at Spice this month. We have received two application for ProSeries bikes for an 18 year old girl and a 19 year old young man. We may need to wait a while on the bike for the young man. We have a more heavy duty ProSeries bike in production that will be available soon which will work much better for the young man. The board has approved the purchase of these two bikes so watch for pictures next month.

Cornbelt also helped purchase a bike for a young girl in St. Louis. This was a combined purchase by several Central Region chapters and I will assemble and deliver the bike. The St. Louis therapist is one of the therapist working to get the new chapter going in St. Louis in which Cornbelt will be the sponsoring chapter. The young girl is non-verbal and has cluster seizures. The therapist was not sure the chapter was going to be organized in time for this girl to have a bike to ride this spring. The Central Region chapters put their shoulders together and made this happen.
