Amtryke activity picked up a little this month. We picked up an AM-12 from a family. The young boy rode the bike for about three years and has now progressed to riding a conventional 2 wheel bike. This is great and the parents feel the Amtryke played a major role in their son's progress to a conventional bike. All we need to do is order a new seat post and back support and the bike will be ready for another rider.

We also will be delivering two 1420s the second week of May. Watch next month for pictures of the two kiddos and their new bikes. There is another bike to be picked up at Danvers school. Not sure how much work needs to be done to refurbish the bike. This will determine if the bike is returned to Cornbelt or stays at the school.

Cornbelt also helped with bike days at Peoria Easter Seals, Mississippi Bend Ambucs in Davenport Iowa, Wisconsin Wheels in La Crosse Wisconsin, and Naperville last month. That all adds up to over 100 kiddos we helped Central Region chapters evaluate and fit kiddos on bikes this spring.

Cornbelt was also contacted by Spice for a potential rider this fall. I am working with them on the evaluation.
