We only had to order a couple replacement parts and the bike worked perfectly. As you can see from the two pictures below she was quite excited to have her new red bike. All the kids in the school we cheering for her.





We also fitted a young man at the Baby Fold on an AM-16 and the bike has been ordered. This is one of the bikes still on back order so let's hope it gets here so he can use his bike while the weather is still nice.

In October we will be fitting three potential new Amtryke recipients at the Danvers Elementary school. If all goes well will be taking the Amtryke trailer there to make sure we have the right bike for each of the kids.

The Tri-Valley physical therapist has asked us to repair a couple of the bikes at the school. This will happen on October 24th.

Also, Larry and I will be taking the Amtryke trailer to Northern Illinois University to demonstrate our bikes to their physical therapy students. They are also interested in seeing what it would take to start an Ambuc chapter with the staff and student doing most of the volunteer work. Will let you know more next month.
