Amtrykes®

February was a busy Amtryke month but not with giving away Amtrykes. Cornbelt Ambucs is the host chapter for the first Amtryke Evaluation and Fitting Training for therapist in the Central Region. There will be at least 27 therapists in training and Ashley Schilling is the lead instructor. Ashley is a key member of the Ambucs Amtryke Advisory Board and is from Murfreesboro, Tennessee. During the training in the afternoon session the therapist will be evaluating 5 kiddos that have received Amtrykes in the past and 5 or 6 new children. Plus we will be assisting a family with an evaluation on Friday afternoon as the family will be out of town on Saturday.

The Physical Therapist attending will be able to receive 5 CCUs, certified by ProCert, for the training session. We are waiting for Occupational Therapist credits to be approved by the State of Illinois.

We hope to present the children in the Bloomington Normal area with their new Amtrykes at the Pancake Breakfast on March 30, 2019. The exact time will determine when the family is available on the 30th.
