Amtrykes®

Last month was a hurry to wait month for us. The 1420 XL Pro Series Amtryke we ordered for the 11 year old Bloomington girl was shipped. However the Amtryke was not received until June so watch for pictures next month.

We also have had a few inquiries from adults wanting to purchase an Amtryke but nothing finalized at this time. We also have borrowed two Amtrykes from the Amtryke trailer and Thunder Adaptive Cycling in Towanda is trying them out. They may have a few requests for bikes in the next month or two.

We will be assembling a veteran's Amtryke in June for a disabled veteran in the Chicago area. I will be delivering the bike and discussing the possibility of a new veteran's chapter. This bike was provided by a grant by National Ambucs. They are offering up to \$100,000 for veteran' and each chapter can submit grants for up to 5 veteran's bikes. At this time we do not have another disable veteran in need of an Amtryke. If you know of one, please let me know.
