
Amtrykes®

We finally received the two rear steering kits that have been on back order. National is sold out of all the 1400 series, foot powered, Amtrykes until September or October. I do not know if they already have more requests than the bikes they expect to receive. Either way, I am advising therapists to complete the evaluation so we can get our request in and hopefully have the Amtrykes by Christmas.

National does have an adequate supply of the AM models, hand and foot powered Amtrykes and we can expect any request to be filled in a couple weeks. National also has a good supply of the recumbent Amtrykes.

I have heard from a few therapists about potential requests, but we have not received the Amtryke Evaluation forms for the board to approve. I expect to receive three or four in the next few weeks.

On March 25th we delivered a 1420 Amtryke to a wonderful little girl at Marcfirst. Averie was so excited to receive her new red Amtryke. Averie is 7 years old and has Cerebral Palsy and wanted a bike she could ride with her family. As you can see from the pictures below, she was extremely excited and loved her new Amtryke.





We also were able to replace the older style 1416 we gave to Maggie last fall. This bike was not in particularly good condition, but it did allow her a bike to ride while we waited for the new bike to arrive. Maggie said the new bike pedals significant easier than the previous bike plus this one has the rear steering so mom can help when needed.
