Ved has some limitations managing his posture on a traditional bike and was not able to pedal with only his feet. The AM-10 hand, and foot powered therapeutic bike should help, and he loves being outside and going on walks around the block. As you can see, he pays very close attention to his therapist, Jamie. Ved was ready to go for a ride very shortly after Jamie adjusted the bike to him.



Ved's family was very excited for him, and they loved the Amtryke. A picture of the family and his therapist, Jamie, is shown below. You can also see Marcia and Don in the background. It was not long before he was leading the family on a walk around the neighborhood.



I want to thank Vicky, Marcia and Don for taking the time to attend the Amtryke presentation. It is always so rewarding to see the smile on the child's face when they see the bike for the first time.

I am also waiting on another Amtryke evaluation for a small child. I hope it is for an Amtryke we have recycled as there are only a few Amtryke styles available from the Ambucs Resource Center. They are looking for a partial shipment in late November or December.
