Lunch Meeting Speaker for our June Meeting

The speaker for our June Lunch meeting was Dee Wilson from the *Penguin Project*. Dee shared the Penguin Project story of their mission and how they came to be in Bloomington IL.

These are some of the things that Dee shared with us:

Once a year, a magical and touching celebration of the human spirit unfolds at U-High's Stroud Auditorium in Normal, Illinois. A group of young people in a program called The Penguin Project® McLean County take to the stage to perform a modified version of a well-known Broadway musical.

This production is unique, however, because all of the roles are filled by children and young adults with developmental disabilities including Down Syndrome, cerebral palsy, autism, intellectual disabilities, learning disabilities, visual impairment, hearing impairment, and other disorders. They are joined on stage by their "peer mentors," a group of young people the same age without disabilities, who have volunteered to work with them side-by-side and guide them through 4 months of rehearsals and to the final production.

By creating unrestricted access to the performing arts, The Penguin Project® McLean County

demonstrates that the special challenges of a disability need not handicap a child's ability to participate in life's many experiences.

June was a busy month for Amtrykes.

We fitted three people for an Amtryke. One girl was at Parkside Elementary School. The 1416 worked well for her and one has been ordered. Unfortunately, we do not have an expected delivery date.



The second one was for a young girl at Easter Seals. They wanted to try her on an AM 16 as she has outgrown her current early intervention Amtryke. We did not have an AM 16 for her to try. However, just prior to our May chapter meeting a family from Lincoln returned an AM 16 to us. We tried the bike for the young girl, and it was a perfect fit. We had to make a few changes due to her shorter than normal arms plus the bike needed a little touch up paint. The bike is ready and waiting for her next appointment at Easter Seals so we can deliver the Amtryke.

The third young lady saw Jeanie's daughter riding her Amtryke in the neighborhood and asked Jeanie how they could obtain an Amtryke for their daughter. Jeanie helped them complete the Amtryke evaluation form and we did a test fitting on the 1420 Pro Series we had in stock. It worked well but it was a three speed and without rear steering. Therefore, we assembled the 1420 we had as an extra and it worked great. The bike was presented to Hannah on June 1 and Jeanie was there to make sure the bike was adjusted properly for Hannah.

As you can tell from the picture below Hannah loved her new bike. Her parents were so happy and looking forward to the family walks in the neighborhood. The family also gave a very nice donation to our chapter.
