Amtryke® News from Al

June was Cornbelt's busiest Amtryke month in a long time.

We began the month with a bike presentation on June 1, 2022. Hannah saw Jeanie's daughter riding her Amtryke in the neighborhood and asked Jeanie what she had to do to get Hannah a bike to ride outdoors. Hannah had ridden a therapeutic bike at school but did not have one to use in the neighborhood. Jeanie explained the process to the family, and we had the bike she needed in our inventory.

As you can tell from the picture below Hannah and her parents really loved the 1420 Pro Series Amtryke.



I want to thank Jeanie for her assistance in making sure Hannah had a bike to ride. Jeanie competed the Amtryke Evaluation form and was there to ensure the bike fit Hannah perfectly when we delivered the Amtryke. Thanks again Jeanie.



The second Amtryke in June went to a 5 ½ year lovely girl. She previously was riding an AM 10 at home, but the bike was too small. Janae received her AM-16 at Easter Seals, and she took off down the hallway. She was ready to go without any coaching. Below is a picture of Hannah on her recycled AM-16.



When we received the request for the AM-16 we did not have one in our inventory. However, a family in Lincoln returned an AM-16 to Larry Turilli and he mentioned this at Cornbelt's noon meeting. The bike needed a little work, but it worked great for Janae when it was refurbished. The family also donated the AM-10 that Janae was no longer able to ride. It was in excellent condition.

It was just two days later we presented the recently donated AM-10 to Emi. She is 2 years old and one of the many children Jamie sees in her early intervention treatments. She is just too cute, and the parents were very much involved while Jamie was getting Emi fitted on the bike. You can see the wonderful condition of the bike in the picture below of Emi, Jamie, and her mother.





We also received another request for an AM-10 which we will have to wait until September or October for a shipment from national. However, maybe someone will return an Amtryke that is not being used and we can refurbish the Amtryke and allow another child to have a bike to ride.
