## Amtryke<sup>®</sup> Newsfrom Al

The first one was a 1416 that was given to Grace at Parkside Elementary School. We were able to refurbish this bike and it allows Grace a bike to ride until the one we order in August arrives. She really needs the rear steering and rear brake adaptions which will give her parents much better control of Grace on the bike. Also, she does not need the three speed and could use the help of the direct drive available with the 1416 bike. However, Grace did not have any problems pedaling the 1416 and the biggest problem was keeping up with her as she rode the bike around the school and helping her steer the bike. I wish I knew when her new bike would be arriving.

The second bike was an early intervention Amtryke, AM-10. We did have the basic bike, the snappy seat with laterals and the 11.5 H harness the therapist requested. Nora is very small, less than30 pounds, for a 2-year-old. Jamie, therapist, indicated Nora loves to watch her brother and sister run and play. Now with her new bike she is capable of playing with her siblings.

Vicky Strauss presented this Amtryke to Nora as I was not able to make it the day the presentation was scheduled. Vicky did wonderful and the mother was very surprised when Nora was able to pedal the Amtryke on her own. Here are a couple pictures of Nora and her therapist.
