As we indicated last month, we do not have any Amtrykes on back order. Unfortunately, we do not have any children waiting on a bike, but I guess that could be considered good news.

We did receive the 1416 Pro Series bike for Grace. This bike replaced the reconditioned Amtryke she was using until the proper bike could be obtained. Grace is a beautiful young girl with lots of energy and her parents indicated she loves riding the Amtryke at home. They have a very nice walk she is able to use.



Grace was very excited at first with all the therapist and assistance waiting for her to get on the new Amtryke at Parkside Elementary School. However, after a few minutes she was ready, and mom and dad had to run to keep up with her. As you can see from the pictures below, she loved her new bike. I think her dad was having fun trying to keep up with her.



After watching Grace for just a few minutes it appears we may need to add the rear steering and back brake to allow the parents to better control her on the bike. Shelley, the school therapist, will work with the parents and let us know if we need to add this to Grace's Amtryke.

We now have a three speed 1416 Pro Series bike when the need arises. Shelley also gave us a 1412 Pro Series Amtryke that had been returned as the child had outgrown the bike. Shelley was going to follow up and see if the child could benefit from a larger Amtryke.
