Cornbelt Ambucs had the wonderful opportunity to present Neako with his first bike. Neako became paralyzed at age 4 and has almost no use of his lower extremities.

He received a 1020 Small Hand Cycle at Easter Seals on Tuesday, April 11th. His therapist, Gretchen, feels the hand cycle will be a great way to release Neako's build up energy. The Amtryke will also allow Neako to be able to participate in activities with other children his age. Unfortunately, we were not able to take any pictures of Neako but trust me the smile on his face was so wonderful.

Cornbelt board agreed to purchase a 1416 Pro Series bike for a child at Benjamin Elementary School. The bike should be received soon so please watch and attend the Amtryke presentation. This will be the first Amtryke we have presented to a child at Benjamin Elementary School and working with a new occupational therapist at the school.

Please continue to send me the contact information on anyone who can benefit from one of our fabulous therapeutic bikes. Many of the bikes are available at the Ambucs Resource Center so we can expect shipments in a very reasonable time frame.
