Amtryke® News from Al

August was a busy month for finding homes for several Amtrykes. At the Regional Caucus chapters mentioned the need for Amtrykes while waiting for back orders to be filled by National.

Cornbelt indicated we had two 1420 XL that we did not have a rider waiting on at this time, but we needed two 1416 Pro Series. The Greater Champaign County Ambucs had one 1416 and they needed a 1420 XL. The switch was made, and we are preparing the 1416 to be presented in early September. We are still waiting for the full padded back, H-harness and the 10-degree seat post but not sure when they will be available.

One of the St. Louis chapters requested the second 1420 XL we have in our stock. We met in Springfield, and they will be sending us a check for the 1420 XL.

Cornbelt Ambucs also had a 1416 returned to us last month. It is an older style so we will need a new front end if a new rider requires the rear steering option. The Amtryke is in excellent condition.

We still have another 1416 with rear steering on back order. Hopefully the Amtryke will become available soon and we can get it to a young girl in Clinton.

We also have two requests for Amtrykes from families because their child has outgrown their current Amtryke. Once we receive the new Amtryke Evaluation from the therapist the request will be taken to the board for approval.

It looks like September will be a busy Amtryke month. Please watch your email for the date and time for the presentation or Amtryke assembly.

As usual please continue to send me contact information for anyone who might benefit from one of our outstanding Amtrykes.
