Last month was very active. We started the month replacing Nathan's 1416 with a 1420. This is the sixth Amtryke for Nathan. We have watched him grow and expand his ability as he outgrows his Amtrykes. The 1420 should last him for several years.

We are still working to get a 1416 Pro Series Amtryke to a young girl from Clinton. Hopefully we can arrange the deliver soon through Easter Seals.

We received a 1410 Amtryke order one month ago. This bike will be delivered on April 12th.

We also fitted a child at Glenn School and Parkside Elementary School. They both need 1416 Pro Series bike which we have in stock. However, first we need the therapist and family to complete the Amtryke evaluation form and required paperwork.

We also received an inquiry for two AM 10 Amtrykes that we have in stock. If the paperwork's gets here. we could possible present 7 riders with their own Amtryke next month.
